#### **SCHOOL BUS PLAN**

In accordance with policies of the Wakefield School Committee, transportation for Grades K-12 will be available to Wakefield Public School Students and students attending St. Joseph School for a fee of \$355.00 per year per student for a two way pass or \$245.00 per student for a one way pass on a space available basis. Please read the following important information:

### **PAYMENT DATES/INFORMATION:**

Transportation payments for your student(s) for the 2019-2020 school year are due by August 1, 2019. Please make checks for pupil transportation payable to "Town of Wakefield." Complete the online application and then mail your check to the Office of the Superintendent of Schools, 60 Farm Street, Wakefield, MA 01880, ATTN: Transportation. For your convenience, you may logon to our website at <a href="https://www.wakefieldpublicschools.org">www.wakefieldpublicschools.org</a> and use our Online Payment system.

## **NO CHARGE TRANSPORTATION:**

Transportation will be furnished without charge by the School Committee in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws (Ch. 71, S. 68 and Ch. 76, S. 1) to all pupils from kindergarten through grade six who live two or more miles walking distance from the public school to which they are normally assigned. (Please see over 2 mile street list →). Additionally, transportation will be furnished without charge to any student regardless of grade level or distance if the pupil is on Free / Reduced Lunch Status or the pupil's Individual Educational Plan (I.E.P.) specifies transportation to be provided by the School Committee. Special needs pupils who are eligible for transportation will receive instructions from the Special Education Office.

#### TRANSPORTATION AVAILABILITY:

Currently there is no transportation available to the Greenwood or Walton Schools. Out of district students are not eligible to participate in any part of the Transportation Program. It is not possible to make additional stops even if the bus is passing your residence. Buses are not authorized to enter cul-desacs for student pick up or drop off. As soon as school

opens and routes have settled, we will review your concerns. Busing will be available for St. Joseph School students according to the public school calendar.

#### **BUS PASSES/SCHEDULES:**

Bus passes will be issued to students on the first day of school provided bus fees have been paid in full. School bus rider passes are issued for the exclusive use of the pupil whose name appears on the rider pass and are effective for the current school year only. Students are required to carry their bus passes daily beginning the second day of school. Bus schedules and stops will be established consistent with the time needs of the school system. Bus stops for High School pupils will be limited to one or two regional stops for each bus. Notification of bus stops and locations for bus pass distribution will be sent via e-mail the week before school begins and will be available on our website at www.wakefieldpublicschools.org

Bus transportation via MBTA is available to Galvin Middle School Students. Half price fares are available with a MBTA pass that is available at the Galvin Middle School Office. Information on fares and routes is available in the Wakefield Guide and Directory or on the MBTA web site (www.mbta.com).
