Saint Joseph School – Christmas Craft Fair Rules and Regulations

Applicants will be notified of acceptance / rejection by October 31, 2019. Checks must be made payable to **Saint Joseph School**. Checks will be returned if the vendor application is not accepted.

1. The Saint Joseph School Christmas Craft Fair aims to create a unique shopping experience with a diverse selection of *quality* art, crafts and wares. All applications will be reviewed and selected in an effort to minimize duplication of products presented at the fair. We welcome any pictures or additional details of your product to help assist us in the selection process.
2. Displays will be inspected for appropriateness of items. Resale items, garage sale, flea market, mass produced items or animals not allowed. Weapons of any kind, including toys and laser pointers are strictly prohibited. The committee reserves the right to request the removal of any items that are inappropriate for a school-sponsored craft fair.
3. Once the application is confirmed, payment is considered non-refundable unless we are able to re-sell the space by **November 1, 2019**.
4. All vendors are responsible for their own set-up and take-down.
5. All vendors are expected to be in their reserved space during the fair.
6. We have gone to considerable effort to allow for the maximum number of booths, and to allow for a proper and safe aisle space. Expect to be asked to move if you are in any way outside your marked space. Vendors must bring their own tables. The standard spaces are **EXACTLY 8 feet by 6 feet** – spaces are adjacent to each other. Please bring an appropriate set-up to fit in an 8 by 6 space. A table that takes up the entire width of your space does not allow for exit or entrance to your spot, please be respectful to your neighbors and bring an appropriate sized display. Your items will need to be removed if they are outside your spot – aisles must remain clear. There will be no exceptions made to this.
7. Only those vendors who have applied and been accepted by the Christmas Craft Fair Committee are allowed to sell their wares. Unless specified on the application, tables cannot be shared or sublet with unapproved exhibitors.
8. Upon acceptance, written notification will be sent with instructions for booth set-up, location and tear down. Exhibitors must park in designated areas after unloading. Violators will be towed at the owners' expense.
9. Exhibitors must be in place by 3:30 pm on Friday, and 9:30 am on Saturday. If not, the exhibitor is considered a "no show". Breakdown will not begin until the end of the fair on Saturday 3 pm for two day vendors and Friday at 8 pm for single day vendors.

It is our commitment to host a successful show and to ensure the enjoyment and comfort of both the visitors and the exhibitors who attend. We thank you for your participation; your positive attitude is what makes this a successful event year after year!
